

(A) FEES: Certificate, Diploma, Degree and Post-Graduate Degree

The following fees for the Academic Year 2010-2011 payable on Registration Day for Mauritian students are as follows:

1. Administrative Fee (yearly): Rs3,500/- 2. Student Union Fee (yearly): Rs200/- 3. Tuition Fees (payable in full on Registration or in instalments)

Full Time: Tuition fees (per semester): Rs22,300/-

Application Fee: Rs500/-
