1. The Board of Governors of the University of Technology, Mauritius (UTM) is pleased to inform prospective students and the public in general of the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Murdoch University (MU), Australia.
2. Through this MoU, UTM and MU will jointly offer undergraduate programmes in the field of Business, Management, Finance and Tourism.
3. This arrangement will allow students to start the respective programme in Mauritius and complete them in MU in Perth, or vice versa. Upon successful completion, students will receive a degree from UTM and a degree from MU.
4. Prospective students are informed that the free tuition fee policy shall apply for that portion of the programme of study that is followed at the UTM.
