Noise Policy

The University Resource Centre is committed to providing an environment that is favourable to study as well as welcoming to all users. All library staff and users of the library should respect the rights of others and refrain from disturbing other members while using the Resource Centre.

Behaviour within the Resource Centre premises

- Silence is required throughout the Resource Centre
- Library users should refrain from making unnecessary noise/engage in conversations that could be disruptive to other users.
- Use of mobile music players without headphones is not authorized. Sound from headphones should not be audible to others.
- Mobile phones should be switched off before entering the Resource Centre and should not be used anywhere within the Resource Centre.
- Laptops/computers may be operated, but all sound or audio features must be turned off.
- Group discussions are not allowed.
- Lecture groups should not normally be brought to the Resource Centre without prior arrangement with the Head of Resource Centre.

Resource Centre users are expected to abide by this policy failing which he/she may be requested to leave the Resource Centre. Serious cases of misconduct in the Resource Centre will be dealt with as per the UTM regulations.
