

UTM Shines in Times Higher Education Impact Rankings 2024

The University of Technology, Mauritius (UTM) reaches a monumental milestone – its 24th anniversary! This achievement coincides with our impressive ranking in the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Ranking 2024! A heartfelt thanks to our students, dedicated alumni, academic and non-academic staff as well as to all part time resource persons involved in the delivery of UTM academic programmes.

This year's THE Impact Rankings saw record participation, with over 2,152 universities evaluated globally. In this context, the contributions and achievements of two Mauritian universities were recognized, namely University of Technology, Mauritius (UTM) and the University of Mauritius (UoM). Both HEIs were ranked overall in group #1001-1500 out of the 2152 universities evaluated – record participation out of the 32000+ HEIs worldwide with certain online visibility. The overall scores are based on the mandatory submission for SDG 17 (Partnership for the Goals) and the best three SDGs per university. UTM is proud to be positioned within the top group **1001-1500** worldwide, demonstrating our commitment to social impact. But UTM's success does not stop here! We achieved a remarkable ranking in the **#301-400 range for SDG 1** (No Poverty: active engagement in developing poverty solutions through rigorous research and innovative educational programmes) – a first for a Mauritian university. This marks a historic first for UTM's dedication to developing innovative solutions and educational programs that empower future leaders to tackle poverty and its root causes.

This recognition by THE serves as a powerful validation of UTM's unwavering commitment to social responsibility. We are dedicated to fostering a culture of sustainability within our institution, equipping our students with the knowledge and skills to create positive change in the world.
